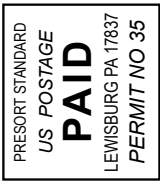

Did You Know?

- Your bid/proposal could be rejected if you don't document outreach efforts to low-income persons and businesses.
- Your organization should develop an Implementation Plan to ensure you properly solicit Section 3 residents and businesses.
- Unmet, published goals for Minority- and Women-Business Enterprises must be explained and justified in your bid/proposal.
- Section 3 regulations allow for bid preference.
- Your employees need to be paid at least once a week.
