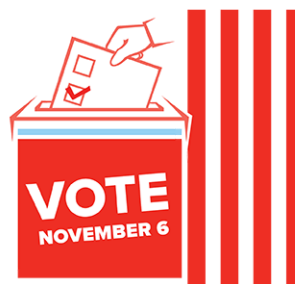

Pennsylvania General Election Important Information

This November 6th you will have the opportunity to vote for Governor, one U.S. Senator, 18 U. S. Congressional members, 203 PA House members and 25 PA Senators in Pennsylvania.

Currently in the **Pennsylvania House of Representatives**, Republicans have a 121-82 majority. All 203 seats are open for election in the 2018 general election:

- There are 21 open Republican seats due to retirements;
- There are 12 open Democratic seats due to retirements and primary losses;
- 77 Republicans have challengers
- 21 Democrats have challengers

Currently in the **Pennsylvania Senate**, the Republicans have a 34-16 majority. 25 Senate seats are open for election:

- There are five open Republican seats due to retirements and primary losses;
- There are zero open Democratic seats;
- 12 Republicans have challengers
- One Democrat has a challenger

PBA supported candidates are in tough races and they need your vote! Voting is one of the most important responsibilities we have as a U.S. citizen and as Pennsylvanians. It's our chance to select leaders who understand the issues residential builders face and whose rhetoric will match their votes in Harrisburg and in Washington.

We need elected officials who not only understand the economic importance of residential construction in Pennsylvania, but who will also embrace our concerns when it comes time to vote on legislation dealing with such issues as taxation, building codes, and regulatory overreach.
